



What is JCI?

JCI – Junior Chamber International is a global network of young active citizens with more than 200.000 members aged between 18 and 40, and millions of alumni in more than 100 countries. Our mission is to **provide development opportunities that empower young people to create positive change** by developing our leadership skills, social responsibility, entrepreneurship and fellowship.

What do we do?

We meet at local, regional and national meetings and international conferences. We learn through interesting and interactive seminars and presentations by dynamic speakers and trainers. We grow both personally and professionally because we learn by doing and actively participate in organizing projects and activities for ourselves and for our communities.



What is JCI Copenhagen International (JCICI)?

JCI Copenhagen International (JCICI) is the first English speaking chapter in Denmark and provides a forum for young international expatriates and Danes with an international mindset. Since the foundation in 2003 we have gathered members from all parts of the world – from various backgrounds and educations. JCI is nonreligious and non-political. Our members exchange ideas and learn how to interact on a cross-cultural basis. This is also a place where people get together and make friends in a relaxed atmosphere.

How often do we meet?

We meet the third Thursday of every month for our chapter meeting 18-21.30. Typically we invite a guest speaker or visit a company or organization – or we arrange a training session. We also meet for projects, trainings and conferences - and social events and fun. Networking is all about getting to know people!

How much does it cost?

Membership fee is 900 DKK twice a year and allows you to participate in any meeting, seminar, training or conference around the world. You also get access to the national membership database of JCI Denmark and you will receive magazines and newsletters. The monthly meetings cost around 150 DKK for members and a little more for guests including dinner.

What is expected from you and how do you become a member of JCI Copenhagen International?

We expect our members to be committed and participate actively in the monthly chapter meetings and other project and activities – **what you get is what you give**. We suggest that you participate in 2-3 events before we decide together whether membership is something for you. All members should also join one of the committees. Be ready to challenge yourself and try something new.
